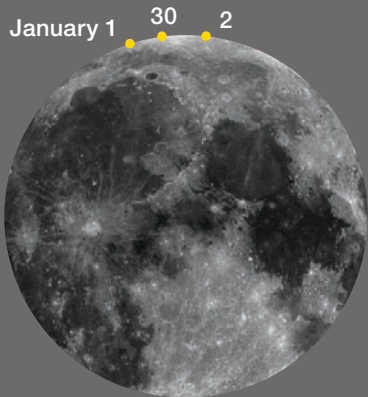


The Moon • January 2018
