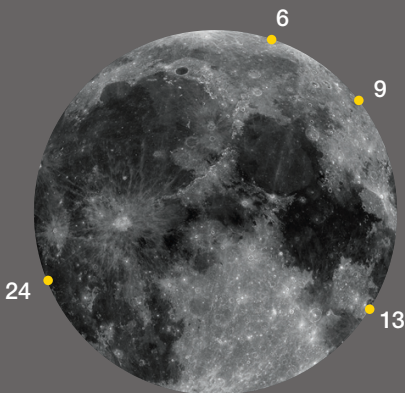


The Moon • March 2017
