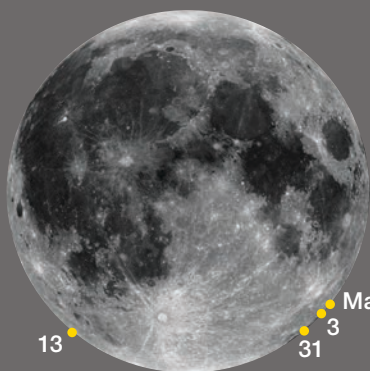


# The Moon • March 2018
